Joseph in Egypt

Foamy Feet Magnets

Supplies

- Sheets of craft foam, 1 for each kid (or you can use Cardstock if you do not have foam)
- Pencils
- Scissors
- Magnets (that can be stuck on the back of a craft project) or Tape
- Permanent markers
- Glue
- Stickers if desired

Activity Instructions

Tell your child(ren) **“Joseph’s story teaches us that God is always walking with us, even when things are hard. Today we are going to make foamy feet magnets to remember how God walks with us.”**

1. Give each child a sheet of craft foam (or paper). Have child(ren) take off their shoes and socks. Ask the child(ren) to stand on the craft foam and have another family member trace both feet of with a pencil.
2. Cut out the feet.
3. Ask child(ren) to write “God walks with me!” on one footprint and “I walk with God” on the other footprint. Write these sentences on a piece of paper so the child(ren) will know how to spell the words.
5. Stick the magnets to the top back side of each footprint. If the magnets are not self-adhering, use a dab of glue. If you do not have magnets tape the feet to the refrigerator when complete.
6. Invite the child(ren) to decorate their footprints further by drawing with the markers and putting on stickers.
7. Tell your child **“Your foamy feet magnets are wonderful. You can put them on your fridge. Every time you see them, they will remind you that God walks with you and you walk with God.”**
