## The Burning Bush

### **Supplies**

- 1 Piece of construction paper any color
- 1 printed photo of your child(ren)
- · Pencils, Markers, Glue sticks
- Foam letter stickers if you have them in the letters of your child's name
- · Variety of decorating items (such as glitter, sequins, stickers, etc.), optional

#### **Activity Instructions**

Talk to your child(ren) about their name and today's activity - We are going to make an art project that you can hang in your house as a reminder that God knows you and loves you. God knows your name. Every one of you has a name. Most of us have two or three names that we put together to make up our whole name—a first, a middle, and a last name. Who decided what your full name would be? (parents) Names are important. They help us know whom we are talking to, and if the person is not there, they help us know whom we are talking about. Remember in our Bible story today, God called Moses by his name. God knows who you are and everything about you—the good things and the bad things—and God loves you!

- 1. Give each child a piece of construction paper and his or her photo
- 2. Have the child(ren) glue their picture in the center of the construction paper so the paper forms a frame around the picture.
- 3. Help your child (ren) write "God Knows me" on one side of the picture. Then either use foam stickers to put the child(ren)'s name on the frame or write it with markers.
- 4. Have fun decorating remaining sides of the frame. Personalize it with crayons, markers, stickers, glitter or anything else you have on hand.
